The Holiday Showcase

The CFSC Holiday Show is scheduled for December 18th at 5:30 PM. Everyone please be at the rink dressed and ready to perform at 4:30 PM.

A copy of your music should be provided to Sara Dean by December 5th. Also, if you would like to volunteer to help with the show setup and/or other duties such as reception coordination or selling tickets, please contact Rebecca Thaxton.

A show participation fee of \$ 40.00 is required by all CFSC members. The fee should be paid to CFSC and given to Patsy Tighe or to the ice monitor for deposit. To ensure proper credit, indicate on your check the fee is for "Show Fee".

The **DRESS REHEARSAL** for the show is Saturday December 17th from 9-11:00 AM for all participants.

All participants are asked to bring a baked good or snack food on the evening of the show for the reception.

Each \$40 participation fee comes with 2 adult admission tickets. The tickets will be provided on the day of the dress rehearsal once your \$40.00 fee has been paid.

The entrance fee for the Ice Show will be \$ 4.00 for seniors 65 and older and children 12 and under, and \$ 8.00 for all others.

In addition, the show will also include a holiday "production number" to be choreographed by Vicky Robb. This is open to all participants and can be performed in addition to your solo or group number, or if desired, you may only sign up for the production number.

There will be additional practices for this program-- one on Saturday Dec. 10th from 8-9 AM and another time which is TBD, if needed. The cost for performing in the production number is only \$10.00 which includes both practice times. A sign-up sheet for the production number is located on the CFSC locker room door. **Please sign up by the above stated deadline of Dec. 5th.**
