### Test Session

**The date for the next test session has been changed from Sunday April 11th to Saturday April 10th.** Testing will be held on Saturday from approximately 6 AM to Noon, 2:30 –4:30 PM, and possibly from 9:00 –11:00 PM if necessary depending on the number of tests required. As will be discussed further herein, a LTS Competition will be held on Sunday April 11th. Test forms have been provided to the coaches. All test forms are due by March 14th, with a \$ 30.00 late charge applied to any forms received after this date.

### Spring Show

The Spring Show will be held on Sunday May 2nd. The theme for the show will be programs skated to music from Walt Disney movies and/or with a Disneyland theme. Show details and program requirements, as well as a sign up sheet are provided on the CFSC locker room door. There will be a separate sign-up sheet for learn to skate participants. The show fee is \$ 40.00 and will be due before or on the date of the dress rehearsal which will be held on Saturday May 1 from 9-11 AM. In general, club members can choose to perform a solo OR group number (not both). Time limits on the programs are based on testing as follows:

**No Moves Testing: - No Solo**

**Passed Pre-Pre or Prel. Moves—1:30 minutes**

**Passed Pre-Juv to Intermediate Moves—2:00 minutes**

**Passed Novice to Senior Moves—3:00 minutes**

Please note, if you are involved in a group number, the time limit can be based on the individual in the group with the highest testing level. **The deadline for sign up is March 10th.**

### Officers/Board Members Wanted
